Standing Stone State Park covers nearly 11,000 acres on the Cumberland Plateau of north-central Tennessee. The quaint and rustic park is noted for its outstanding scenery, spring wildflowers, fossils and other natural diversity. The park takes its name from the Standing Stone, an eight-foot tall rock standing upright on a sandstone ledge, which was supposedly used as a boundary line between two separate Indian nations. When the rock fell, the Indians placed a portion of it upon an improvised monument to preserve it. The stone is still preserved in Monterey, Tennessee. **Directions:** I-40 exit 288N to Livingston - Hwy 52W. Approximately 10 miles. **Rate it a 4.**

The Dale Hollow Dam Campground is located just below Dale Hollow Dam on the Obey River Tailwater in Celina, TN. There is no direct access to Dale Hollow Lake from this campground. The campground offers 79 sites. Water and electric hookups are available. Additional amenities include hot showers, a dump station, a picnic shelter, fish cleaning station, fishing piers, bike trail, laundry facilities, a public telephone, and playgrounds. The Obey River is known for rainbow and brown trout fishing. Adjacent to the Dale Hollow Dam Campground is the Dale Hollow National Fish Hatchery. An aquarium and raceways are available for touring daily 7am to 4pm. **Rate it a 4**
