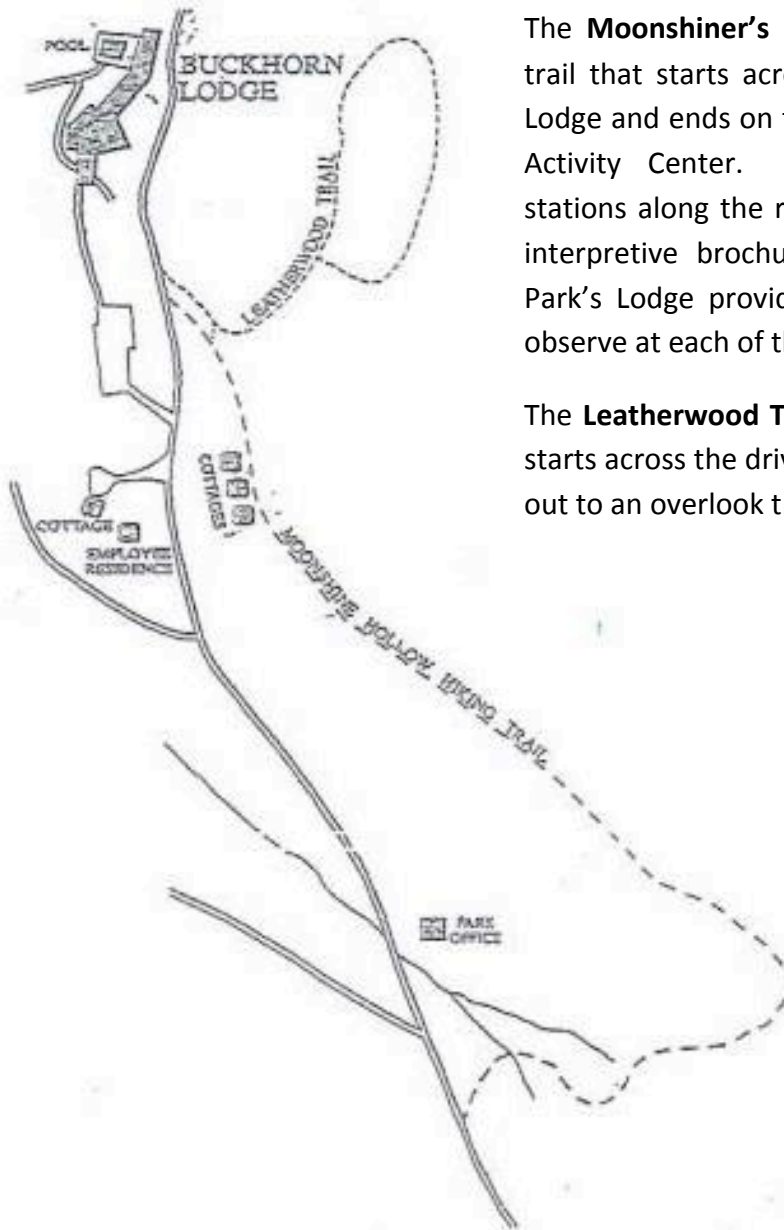

### APPENDIX C Existing Public Trails

There are four existing public trails in the Buckhorn Trail System subject area. They are the Leatherwood Loop and the Moonshine Hollow Hiking Trail near the lodge at Buckhorn Lake State Resort Park (shown below) and two USACE trails near the Buckhorn Tailwaters (see map on following page).



The **Moonshiner's Self-Guided Trail** is a 1 mile trail that starts across the drive from Buckhorn Lodge and ends on the Park Road below the Park Activity Center. There are ten numbered stations along the route that coordinate with an interpretive brochure one can pick up at the Park's Lodge providing details of what one will observe at each of these stations.

The **Leatherwood Trail** is a .5 mile trail that also starts across the drive from Buckhorn Lodge, goes out to an overlook then loops back.
