## CHAPTER V The “Backbone” of the Buckhorn Trail System

The map below shows how five interconnecting trails form the backbone for the Buckhorn Trail System connecting the City of Buckhorn, Buckhorn Lake State Resort Park and Trace Branch Campground. They include Backbone A (aka Buckhorn Trail), Backbone B (aka Lakeview Trail), Backbone C (aka Fire Break Trail), Backbone D (aka Coal Fields Trail), and Backbone E (aka Trace Branch Trail). The total length of the Backbone Trail System is a 24.7 mile linear trail. Each trail has its own unique characteristics and offerings.

<b>Backbone A</b>	26,587	5.0	From Buckhorn Trailhead to Eagle’s Landing Campground
<b>Backbone B</b>	31,363	5.9	From Eagle’s Landing Campground to State Park Trailhead
<b>Backbone C</b>	30,986	5.9	From State Park Trailhead to Events Trailhead A
<b>Backbone D</b>	18,074	3.4	From Events Trailhead to Coal Field Trailhead
<b>Backbone E</b>	23,159	4.4	From Coal Field Trailhead to Trace Branch Campground
<b>Total</b>	130,169	24.6	From Buckhorn Trailhead to Trace Branch Campground
